The countertops in your home may well be some of the most used surfaces rivaling, perhaps, only your floor surfaces for frequency of use. With that in mind, we hope the following information will answer frequent questions about solid surface countertops.

What is Solid Surface?

Most people don't know what Solid Surface is — except by the brand-name **Corian®**. Corian® was the first solid surface product on the market, but today, many companies offer solid surface material in an ever widening array of color choices!

Effortless beauty; Seamless elegance; Unparalleled beauty

Imagine a surface that allows you to create the look and design you've always wanted. Solid Surface products are solid (not a thin layer of veneer), nonporous and do not require sealing. They're naturally resistant to heat, mold, mildew and most stains, even tough stains are easily buffed away. They're renewable and repairable -- scratches are easily repaired. Featuring inconspicuous, waterproof seams ideal for custom designs like drain boards or coordinating seamlessly with Solid Surface sinks and bowls.

Solid Surface Integrated Undermount Sinks:

We offer a number of lines of solid surface double and single bowl sinks, bar sinks, and vanity bowls which come in a variety of styles. Each features seamless construction for great looks and easy maintenance, and are deeper than many stainless steel or cast iron sinks. They are chemically-bonded to the solid surface countertop creating a smooth, one-piece look from countertop to sink. There are no grout lines, lips or recesses to collect bacteria and mold. All are renewable, just like the Solid Surface countertops they complement

Care and Cleaning:

General Cleaning: For day to day cleaning, warm soapy water or non-abrasive household cleaners such as glass cleaner, Fantastik®, Formula 409® or commercially available solid surface cleaners will remove most residues. Then rinse and towel dry the surface to prevent spotting especially in areas with hard water. For a final touch, you may apply Protect All Shine Plus™ or Countertop Magic™ (available at Home Depot or Lowes) to your countertop for a clean, dry professional appearance.

For stubborn residue that will not come out with day to day cleaning methods requires a slightly stronger cleaner. In these cases, apply a mild abrasive cleaner such as Soft Scrub® and a damp sponge, rub in a circular motion. Then rinse and towel dry. If additional blending is necessary, lightly buff with a gray (7448) Scotch-Brite™ pad then rinse and towel dry.
